
The Inclusion Huddle is bringing together all the stakeholders - Academic Institutions, Corporate, NGOs and Students with Disabilities in Mumbai.



# CONCEPT NOTE NATIONAL INCLUSION HUDDLE 20, 21 SEPTEMBER 2019

Program: National Inclusion Huddle - Fostering Disability Inclusion in Higher

Dates: 20th, 21st September 2019

Among the total population of 21 million Persons with Disabilities in India, less than 0.12 million are graduates, which is not even 1%. A recent survey by NCPEDP indicated only 0.56% student with disability pursue higher education. Low enrolment of students with disability indicate the social and academic barriers faced by them in enrolling in higher educational institutions which result in less employment opportunities. The major reasons for this are inadequate accessibility, lack of awareness among the colleges on how to be inclusive and on the other hand students are unaware on how and where to apply in the colleges accepting them with disabilities. This keeps persons with disabilities in a vicious cycle of poverty. The path out of this vicious cycle is education and employment. It is, in fact, clearly stated that unless vulnerable populations like the disabled get equal access to education and employment opportunities, the SDG goals cannot be met.

The proposed National conference aims to create a platform to listen to voices of main stakeholders from across the country - youth with disabilities and their parents, educational institutions, employers who hire youth with disabilities and government. The plan is to integrate these voices into the Youth4Jobs program which is the largest in the country today in inclusive education and employment.

The conference is timely. Recently in a landmark judgement invoking the new RPwD Act, the Supreme Court (SC) passed a set of directions to ensure that Universities and Colleges have disabled-friendly campus, learning facilities and provide 5% reservation quota for persons with disability, as mandated by law. The SC directed the University Grants Commission (UGC) to monitor the fulfilment of the reservation quota for disabled students.

During our recent visits to colleges in Mumbai we found that the colleges are ready to enrol person with disabilities but they are not aware on the aspects of accessibility. Hitherto the Institutions who are enrolling them are not able to provide accessible

education and support them in employment. In most of the universities and institutions the placement rates of students with disabilities are dismal. In premier institutions also they don't get jobs and most of the time they are not even part of the campus placement process.

This National conference plans to address some of these important issues in education and employment of youth with disabilities. On one hand, there will be demonstration of best teaching practices, sensitization workshops, advocacy, awareness on educational and legal rights of students with disability. On the other hand, we are inviting professors, special educators, social workers, companies to share their best practices in an inclusive environment.

We are designing the conference on the 4A's of Inclusion:



The conference will cover the following -

- The needs and challenges for achieving the goal of inclusive education in higher educational institution
- Best practices in inclusive education enrolment, assistive aids, tools and technology, faculty development, teaching learning methodologies and best inclusion practices
- Success stories from corporate with inclusion practices
- Exposure to students on the employment opportunities
- Opportunity for the corporate to interact with prospective students with disabilities for recruitment
- Live demonstration through exhibitions, inclusion booths, Panel discussions and workshops
- Session on the directions of the Supreme Court
- Give awards to educational institutions, NGOs and companies which have supported Youth4Jobs in their work of inclusion
