No. 28 of 2015), hereby declares and notifies the educational courses of study mentioned in column (2) of the schedule appended hereto shall be the Professional Education and specifies that the conditions and the requirements for admissions mentioned in respect of such courses, in column (3) of the schedule shall be the eligibility conditions and requirements, therefor.

- a. 'B.Sc.' means Bachelor of Science
- b. 'BCA' means the Bachelor of Computer Applications
- c. 'BCS' means the Bachelor of Computer Science
- d. 'HSC' means the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.
